FLEX-TEMPORARY NOT TO EXCEED 26 SEP 2010

DUTIES: Continuously observes swimming area to ensure safety of patrons, Ensures the swimming area is open to patrons at scheduled times and only authorized persons are admitted to the area. Rescues swimmers in trouble, promptly administers first aid, and calls for medical assistance if and when needed. Warns swimmers of unsafe environmental or health conditions, ocean conditions of rough water hazards, and recommends closing swimming areas until safe conditions prevail. When working at pools may operate water pumps and control chemical additives to ensure pool water meets specified standards. Ensures that diving boards inspected frequently for cracks or loose matting, and that necessary repairs are made. May perform other related or incidental duties as assigned for the daily operation of the swimming area to include: cleaning of bath houses, wading pools, main pools, pool decks, beach areas, sunbathing areas etc.

QUALIFICATIONS: Must have an approved and current nationally recognized certification in lifesaving and water rescue methods and skills, as well as basic first aid training, and CPR (both child and adult) training. For coastal lifeguards: In addition to the above, must also have surf rescue techniques training. Must have experience which provides a practical knowledge of swimming activities, rules and procedures and skill in the use maintenance of various pool and safety equipment is desirable. Satisfactory completion of installation record checks, and state and nation criminal background checks may be required for positions that provide lifesaving duties for children. Must be able to satisfactory complete a physical examination.

Interested applicants are required to complete and submit OF 612 AND OF 306 to the NAF Human Resources Office, 374 Maynard Street Ste 108 (Bldg 306, rm 108), Pope AFB by the closing date in order to be considered.

Applications remain on file for 90 days and are considered as vacancies occur.

Current NAF employees complete and submit AF Form 2550, NAF Application for Promotion or Other Position Change.
